## Modern Games: Pros and Cons & Showing

## Pros:

They are easy to house, requiring only a small draft free shelter – nothing special.

They are easy to breed. You can combine many different colors together and it will give you a variety, an example being a black male and a brassy back female will throw out black chicks.

The bantam Moderns are very tame and easy to handle. They are easy to train for show posing and are small and friendly. The standard size Moderns are still as easy to train for posing but are a little difficult to handle at times.

## Cons:

The standard Moderns tend to be skittish at times.

Dubbing: In order to show Modern Game Cockerels and Cocks, they have to be dubbed. Dubbing is the removal of the comb, wattle, and earlobe.

## Showing:

It is best not to feed your Moderns before judging. The crop is very exposed in this breed, so it will stick out. You will want to keep the water dishes high up on the cage in order to encourage your bird to reach for their water and food, as this makes them pose and it also makes them stretch out their long necks.
